ALLERGEN

DESCRIPTION:

Sweetened, shredded, flake, macaroon, medium or chip coconut. Can be used as a topping or ingredient in cakes, cookies etc. The product is prepared, processed and packaged under modern sanitary conditions in accordance with good manufacturing practices. Product shall be free of defects and decay and shall comply in every respect with the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act.

INGREDIENTS:

Coconut, sugar, water, propylene glycol, salt and sodium metabisulfite (added as a preservative).
