1 TOOLS REQUIRED


1.1 PARTS AND TOOLS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED

- Hose cutter
- · Clamp crimper
- · Screwdrivers (flat & Phillips)
- · Crescent wrench
- · Hole saw (if hole needs to be drilled)



3 MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 MOUNTING GROWLER FILLER

Included:

- · Four (4) mounting bolts, nuts, washers
- Hole pattern (matches 3" column tower base)

Instructions:

- 1. Use mounting template to locate hole to be cut.
- 2. Ensure there is enough clearance for protective cover to be raised.
- 3. Locate electric outlet nearby the Growler Filler will be plugged into.
- 4. Remove back cover of Growler Filler to expose mounting bolts. To remove cover unscrew (4) screws: 2 under lip in front and 2 screws at the base of the back.
- 5. Place gas, beer, water lines through hole.
- 6. Electrical connection does NOT go through hole into counter. The electrical connection will run to electrical socket to be plugged in.
- 7. Tighten mounting bolts.
- 8. Replace cover. Be careful not to scratch clear protective cover on Growler Filler walls while re-inserting into place.

4 CONNECTIONS

4.1 HOSE CONNECTIONS

Instructions:

- 1. From Growler Filler braided hose (white tape stripe) clamp to pneumatic pressure regulator line using 170SL clamps.
- 2. From Growler Filler braided hose (yellow tape stripe) clamp to growler purge pressure line using 170SL clamps.
- 3. Connect growler beer fill lines 1/4" I.D. clear vinyl to beer supply lines (glycol trunk line) using 133SL clamps and appropriate splicer.

4.2 IN-LINE WATER PRESSURE REGULATOR (INCLUDED WITH GROWLER FILLER)

Factory preset to maintain 15 PSI

Connect to either:

- · City water line
- · Dedicated pressurized water container



4.3 ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

· Plug into standard 110 volt outlet

4.4 DRAIN LINES

- PRESSURIZED DRAIN LINE, 3/8" clear vinyl hose marked with single black tape strip
- PLATFORM DRAIN CONNECTION, 3/8" clear vinyl hose marked with double black tape stripe
- · Connect both to drain or waste bottle

NOTE: Drain line is pressurized and must be plumbed to an open site drain.

4.5 GLYCOL COOLING CONNECTION

(IF DESIRED)

Glycol loop of 3/8" I.D. poly hose (550NE) included to maintain beer temperature (from keg) inside Growler Filler.

Cooling sources:

· Recirculating glycol system

5 PRESSURE SETTINGS

5.1 GAS PRESSURE SETTINGS

Gas source and regulators for purge and pneumatic pressure can be mounted near the Growler Filler or in walk in cooler. Gas pressure from the beer system can also be used.

Instructions:

- 1. Mount secondary regulators in preferred location
- 2. Adjust gas purge pressure to 1 PSI higher than pressure applied to the keg
- 3. Adjust pneumatic pressure to 25-30 PSI

6 OPERATION

6.1 OPERATION

Turn on power switch, LED touch panel illuminates. Follow on-screen prompts. See complete instructions included with Growler Filler (GF-14515-G2).
