





Butler XP INSTALLATION AND OPERATION

The Butler XP paging system pages one pager or a group of pagers with one preprogrammed message. To program the Butler XP, you will need the Programming Kit - LRS Part Number KIT-0005. If you do not have this kit, please contact your local LRS representative.

Installation

To put the Butler XP in operation:

Note: If your Butler XP is not already programmed, refer to the programming guide first.

- 1. Install the 2 AA batteries in the Butler.
- 2. Place the optional labels for showing Butler ID number or for advertising.
- 3. Locate the pole where the Butler is to be used.
- 4. Use the provided Velcro straps or rubber bands (or optional Umbrella Holder) to attach the Butler to the pole (the rubber feet will prevent slipping.)
- 5. Turn on the pager (refer to the pager booklet).
- 6. Press the button on Butler to test the pager.


Mount To Pole with Rubber Bands


- 1. Hold the Butler XP against the pole to mount.
- 2. Place one end of rubber band and hook to Rubber Band Mount.
- 3. Wrap rubber band around pole and hook to other side Rubber Band Mount.
- 4. Repeat for second set of Mounts.



Mount To Pole with Velcro Straps


- 1. Place the Velcro straps through the Velcro Strap Supports, the Velcro facing out.
- 2. Hold the Butler XP against the pole to mount.
- 3. Wrap straps around pole, loop through buckles, and tighten.







Mount To Wall with Wall Mount Bracket

- 1. Remove all 6 rubber feet. Rubber feet are removed by turning them counter clockwise to unscrew.
- 2. Insert the 4 screws into Butler XP (#6-32 \times 3/8").
- 3. Put 2 wall anchors into wall.
- 4. Use 2 #8 wood screws to secure Wall Mount Bracket.
- 5. Slide Butler XP onto Bracket.






Example: Pool-side Chair
