

FIRST AID

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to or near water. Use Restrictions

For spot, crack, and crevice application only. Do not apply more than 112 lbs. (1792 ounces or 89 bottles) of this product (0.56 lbs. ai PBO) per 1000 square feet. Not for broadcast use on indoor surfaces. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift. Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply when food is present. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Remove pets, birds and cover any water inhabited by fish (such as aquariums and ornamental fish ponds) before spray application. Turn off aquarium filtering systems before spraying and

wait approximately 15 minutes after application before turning the filter back on. [Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before use.]

Do not use in commercial food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other sites where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Not for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils.

Do not make application during rain.

Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip.

Do not use treated article until spray has dried.

Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application.

Close milk bulk lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking.

Do not use in aircraft cabins.

Other than application to building foundations, all outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors and eaves) must be limited to spot or crack and crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses: Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures; Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation; Applications to building foundations, up to a maximum height of 3 feet.

For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. [Remove protective cap.] Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill **Wasps** and **Hornets** returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. To kill **Wasps**, **Hornets**, **Yellow Jackets** and **Bees** under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1 - 2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the house, spray around points where insects can enter house; outside plumbing, faucets, and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges.

Do not spray vegetation directly to prevent damage to foliage. If spray accidentally contacts foliage, immediately wash with water. This product may discolor exterior surfaces of building, structures and painted surfaces and may cause staining (darkening) of asphalt surfaces and shingles. Test product in an inconspicuous area before applying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from [inaccessible to] children and pets and away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Do not freeze.
