Description:

The 3M™ Sky Blue Hi-Performance Burnish Pad 3050 is a high quality floor maintenance pad, made of synthetic fiber, having resins throughout and bonded to the web structure. The burnishing floor pad has been optimized for use on softer floor finishes where frequent burnishing is required.

The burnishing pad has been designed to deliver:

- High pad durability
- Higher gloss
- Reduced burn marks and minimization of dust, point build-up, and swirl marks

Applications:

The pad is for use with high speed equipment operating at 1500-3000 rpm. It is ideal for use on softer floor finishes such as those typically used in retail environments where frequent burnishing is required.

General Use Directions:

1. Dust mop and clean floor surface. 3M™ Easy Trap Duster may be effectively used for dusting floor.
Note: Burnish only on a clean floor.
2. Install 3M™ Sky Blue Hi-Performance Burnish Pad 3050 on a high-speed burnisher. It may be a corded electric, battery, or propane burnisher.
3. Burnish to a high gloss using overlapping passes.
4. Dust mop floor surface with 3M™ Easy Trap Duster.

Maintenance:

1. After burnishing, if next burnishing will be with same pad, leave pad on burnisher. Otherwise, remove pad and store.
2. Examine pad. Remove excessive dust and debris with a brush or vacuum.
3. Flip pad periodically.
4. Discard pad if thickness decreases to point where pad holder hooks extend completely through pad.
